KEY TO THE TRANSCRIPT

History: Lesley College founded in 1909 is an accredited, independent college composed of three academic units: The Undergraduate School, the Graduate School, and the School of Programs in Management for Business and Industry (PMBI).

Degrees: Associate, Bachelor, Master, Doctor of Philosophy.

Accreditation: New England Association of Schools and Colleges. Individual programs are accredited or endorsed by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and/or by the Interstate Certification Compact (ICC) and by other learned societies.

Unit of Credit: Semester Credit Hour.

Calendar: The Undergraduate Day School uses the traditional two-semester academic calendar. The Graduate School and PMBI are in session twelve months of the year.

Course Numbering: Only students who have been awarded an Undergraduate degree are eligible to earn Graduate credit.

0 - 4000 Associate/Bachelor Level  
5000 - 7000 Master/C.A.G.S. Level

Prior to 1986, course numbering was 0 - 400 (Associate/Bachelor level);

Experiential Learning Credit: Experiential Learning Credit is awarded for learning gained outside of the classroom. The student's portfolio is evaluated by Faculty readers representing a cross-section of faculty expertise in a variety of academic disciplines.

Inter-State Certification Compact: A statement is printed on all transcripts of students who have finished teacher-education programs. It indicates completion of a training program approved by ICC - NASDTEC.
